M.V. & M.V. Scrapie Monitored or Non-M.V. Status must be stated on the entry forms. Sheep are penned separately depending on their health status. Only Dorset Horn/Polls are accepted as Scrapie Monitored, there is an exception for this County Breed of sheep at its local Show.

A copy of the green S.A.C. M.V. form must be sent with the entry form and the original brought to the Show.
