The first part is run as a Table C competition with a time limit of 120 seconds. Following completion of the first part, competitors may elect to jump the second part or stick with their time established in the first part of the competition. The second part is a joker obstacle set outside of the timed course with a separate start and finish line and a time limit of 60 seconds. Jumping the Joker obstacle successfully without penalty will result in 6 seconds being deducted from their time taken in the first part of the competition. Faulting at the joker (1st refusal or knockdown) will result in 6 seconds being added to their time taken. No jumping penalties are incurred in the interval between each part of the competition.
